

KS1-KS2 Spelling activities

1. Choose a word and write it out using different styles of writing e.g bubble writing.
2. Use your spelling words to create some silly sentences.
3. Design a crossword or wordsearch for a sibling or parent to solve.
4. Word Art: use arts and crafts to make your words stand out!
5. Write your spelling words with coloured pencils. Make each letter a different colour.
6. Type out your spelling words on the computer. Try to use at least 4 different fonts.
7. Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in the picture.
8. Draw an ice-cream cone and write at least 2 synonyms for each of your spelling words on a new flavour.
9. Set a timer for 2 minutes. See how many times you can write each word perfectly during that time.
10. Can you find any homophones which go with your spelling words? What do they mean? e.g. wear and where, to, too and two, their, there and they're.
11. Write jokes containing each of your spelling words.
12. Write an acrostic poem for your spelling words. See if you can stick to a theme when writing. e.g. sun.
13. If you are a Scrabble fan: In a game of Scrabble, each letter is worth a certain number of points. Write your words and then add the total of the letters. Which of your spelling words has the highest total value?
