The engagement and positive learning behaviours this week have allowed us to continue to progress with our learning and the independence that the children are now showing is incredible.

In writing we have immersed ourselves in different texts, identifying the language and features used to entertain. The children have worked together to read the texts and share their ideas to develop their understanding. In maths we have applied our place value understanding to count in different multiples and to different values. The children have enjoyed being mathematical thinkers and using their understanding to solve different problems and challenges during the lesson. Using maths resources has really helped us with this!

In reading and phonics this week, the children have worked incredibly hard to develop their decoding and comprehension skills. We have really enjoyed our shared reading, discussing the texts that we have read in our groups. Story time is an amazing aspect of our routine and it is lovely to see the children sharing a love of reading. We also look forward to hearing about the reading you complete at home as a family! Accelerated Reader books will go home with the children and Bug Club phonics books will be allocated as E-Books for you to access online. We are aiming to see which children can complete the most quizzes about the books that they read as we continue to develop our love of reading!
