



Cedar Class Autumn Term 2020

LITERACY

As Writers, Cedar Class will be writing to inform, creating a final outcome of writing a non-chronological report this half term. Their writing will be based on two texts: "The Great Big Water Cycle Adventure" and "Ask Dr K Fisher about Weather". These texts will be used to support the children's learning throughout this unit of work.

MATHS

As Mathematicians, Cedar Class will be learning all about addition and subtraction as we learn to add and subtract numbers with up to 4-digits. The children will apply their mathematical thinking to solve problems using concrete, pictorial and abstract representations, including the written column method.

RE

As Global Citizens, the children will be learning about 'Who is a Muslim and how do they live?' They will be exploring the sacred words of the Shahadah and how stories of the prophet can impact on the way that Muslims live.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children will be learning all about plants this half term. They will be exploring the different parts of a plant, the conditions that plants need to grow and also the function of the female part of the plant.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be exploring settlement land use patterns. We will learn about Dartmoor National Park using maps and images to identify changes over time.

PE

In PE, we will be exploring movement through gymnastics and developing our skills through a series of circuits. Whilst improving our stamina, we will have a focus on balance and coordination throughout our lessons.
