



YEAR 5/6 AUTUMN TERM 2020

LITERACY

As writers, Year 5/6 will be learning how to inform through different text types. Their work will be linked to the Rainforest and they will focus on different sentence types, how to structure their writing and link their ideas.

MATHS

As Mathematicians this half term the class will be focusing on multiplication and division. The children will learn about square and cube numbers, multiples and factors as well as written methods for multiplication and division. They will then move on to looking at fractions.

RE

We will be exploring why some people believe in God and some people do not. We will be looking at how believing in God may help some people and why it could sometimes be difficult to be a Scientist and a Christian.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, Year 5/6 will be exploring states of matter and changes in these. We will be investigating reversible and irreversible changes. We will be planning and investigating in order to draw our own conclusions and learning about dissolving and filtering.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be exploring longitude and latitude, time zones around the world and comparing locations in the Northern and Southern Hemisphere.

PE

In PE, Year 5/6 will be building on their Touch Rugby skills as well as developing their skills in various team building sports.
