

### LITERACY

As Writers, Cedar Class will be writing to entertain, creating a final outcome of writing a newspaper report this half term. Their writing will be based on a range of texts, both fiction and non-fiction, to support the development of the writing skills the children will be learning throughout this unit of work.

### MATHS

As Mathematicians, Cedar Class will be learning all about money as we begin this half term of learning. The children will apply their mathematical thinking using concrete, pictorial and abstract representations to solve problems in context using money. The children will also have the opportunity to revisit and consolidate their understanding of the four operations as we continue towards the end of this half term.

### RE

In RE, the children will be learning about the concept of Salvation as part of their learning about Christianity. The children will be considering why Christians call the day that Jesus died Good Friday and the impact that the events of Holy Week have on the lives of Christians today.

### SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children will be learning all about animals, including humans, this half term. They will be exploring the digestive system, teeth, the skeleton/muscles and food chains.

### GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be comparing and contrasting urban and rural settlements within the UK and within a region of a European country. The children will use maps and images to identify physical and human features of the different locations.

### PE

In PE, Year 2/3/4 will be working on team building games as we return to school following the national lockdown. They will continue to develop their learning and skills supported by our collaboration with secondary colleagues at Spires school.
