

LITERACY

This half term we will continue looking at writing to entertain. We will start with a two week unit focusing on creative writing and poetry before revisiting previous learning when back in class. We will focus our next learning on a film unit looking at building sentence structure and a wide variety of vocabulary.

MATHS

In maths this half term we will start by looking at angles and properties of different shapes which will move on to measuring and drawing angles when back in class. We will then progress to recapping the four operations and methods learnt in the Autumn term to ensure we are confident with these strategies. We will also revisit fractions to focus on the areas that were not covered during remote learning.

RE

We will be exploring what Christians believe that God did to save humans. Pupils will revisit the Easter story and think about what is meant by the concept of Salvation. We will also be considering the impact of Holy Week on the lives of Christians today.

SCIENCE

Building on the work on life cycles in Spring 1, Year 5/6 will be exploring animals and their habitats, looking at animal classification, microorganisms and the creatures that live in our local habitat.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be comparing two large settlements in Devon and looking at different statistics, land use and locations.

PE

In PE, Year 5/6 will be working on team building games. They will continue to develop their learning and skills supported by our collaboration with secondary colleagues at Spires school.

Relationships, Health and Education

In RHE we will be focusing on belonging to a community. Within this we will learn about how we can be responsible global citizens as well as being responsible in our local community. We will also look at the terms 'stereotype' and 'prejudice' and understand what is meant by these.
