



Cedar Class Spring Term 1 2022

LITERACY

As Writers, Cedar Class will be writing to persuade, creating a final outcome of writing a persuasive letter to Felt Tip Pens in the style of 'The Day the Crayons Quit'. The children will be exposed to a range of skills to include in their writing as they 'stack sentences' together as a class to write a letter back to the Felt Tip Pens. The skills will be transferred into their independent writing when they write their own persuasive letter.

MATHS

As Mathematicians, Cedar Class will be developing their mathematical thinking this half term as they consolidate, and develop, their understanding of Multiplication and Division. The children will apply their mathematical thinking using concrete, pictorial and abstract representations, answering fluency and problem solving questions based upon a range of contexts.

RE

In RE, our learning will focus on the question 'What is it like for someone to follow God?'. The children will explore the story of Noah and the idea of covenant. The children will consider different promises that are made throughout their daily lives.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children in Year 2 will be exploring and investigating the changing season and how it impacts on the environment around us. The children in Year 3 and 4 will be learning about electricity, working scientifically to construct a simple circuit and adapt the circuit for different purposes.

MUSIC

In music, the children will be following the learning platform Charanga as they focus on the unit 'Three Little Birds'. The children will be exploring new, and develop prior, musical skills.

HISTORY

As Historians, the children will be learning about St Mary's Church as a local history study. The children will consider the land and settlement use, making connections to the Domesday Book, and understanding the significance of St Mary's Church over a period of time.

Relationships, Health and Education

In RHE, the Year 2 children will be focusing on 'Safe Relationships' and 'Families and Friendships' this half term. The Year 3 and 4 children will be focusing on 'Families and Friendships' and 'Belonging to a Community' this half term.

PE

In PE, the children will be working with our Sports Partnership to develop their skills through taking part in dance in the village hall.
