The children have had a lovely week in Cedar Class. They showed their creativity in Forest School by making stretchers and they really enjoyed having the chance to try them out.

In writing, the children have reflected upon, and developed, their persuasive writing features. We have finished our persuasive letter and we have started our sentence stacking for a persuasive advert. I wonder if the children can tell you what we are persuading everyone to buy? In maths, the children have considered the relationship between their learning on multiplication and division. The children have developed their understanding of the difference between sharing and grouping when we are dividing, and they have applied this when solving different mathematical problems.

Across the wider curriculum, the children have continued their learning in RE which has a focus on the Story of Noah. The children have considered the question, 'What is it like for Christians to follow God?' and they created a symbol to represent their answer to this question. I really enjoyed looking at the different symbol designs and listening to the children explain the significance of each part of their symbol.
