Dear Parents/ Carers

After the half-term break, I will continue to run the Maths and Grammar Club for all children in year 6. We will be revisiting some topics we have not covered as a result of the lockdowns that we had this year and the previous year. This will be alongside practising some skills that the children have learnt so far in year 6. The children who have attended this half-term have really benefited from these sessions and this has been evident in both their classwork and in their confidence.

We will continue to pick apart some reasoning maths questions and develop fluency skills that the children need to solve various maths problems. We will also look at some of the SATS style grammar questions and how to answer them.

This is a great opportunity for your child so that they have a greater confidence when it comes to problem solving and for when it comes to sitting the SATS papers in May.

This club will take place three times a week, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday, from 8.10 am until 8.40 am. It would be beneficial for your child to attend these sessions each week in order to get the most out of the learning.

In order for the sessions to run efficiently, it is really important that your child arrives in school at 8.10am so that they have time to put away their belongings and be settled ready to start the lesson promptly.
