In our writing lessons we have begun a new unit in writing where we are learning how to write a recount text. We have begun this unit by thinking about the specific writing skills needed for this style of writing. To help guide our writing in our sentence stacking lessons, we are using the book 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll. In maths we have completed our unit on area, perimeter and volume and are now moving on with properties of shape. We will look at this area for the last two weeks in this term.

We loved taking our science out into the school grounds this week. We have been learning about classification and our learning this week focused on invertebrates. We used a classification chart to identify the invertebrates that we found in the school grounds. We surveyed the field, the woodland and the playground.
