



Cedar Class Summer Term 1 2022

LITERACY

As Writers, Cedar Class will be writing to inform, creating a final outcome of writing a non-chronological report about Volcanoes. The children will be exposed to a range of skills to include in their writing as they 'stack sentences' together as a class to write a non-chronological report about Earthquakes. The skills will be transferred into their independent writing when they write their own non-chronological report.

MATHS

As Mathematicians, Cedar Class will be developing their mathematical thinking this half term as they consolidate, and develop, their understanding of the units time and mass, capacity & temperature. Alongside this, the Year 4 children will develop their understanding of decimals. The children will apply their mathematical thinking using concrete, pictorial and abstract representations, answering fluency and problem solving questions based upon a range of contexts.

RE

In RE, our learning will focus on the question 'What kind of world did Jesus want?'. The children will explore hidden meanings of the parable of the Good Samaritan and, therefore, they will develop their understanding of the impact this has on the lives of Christians.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children in Year 2 will be exploring and investigating plants, considering the different types of plants and what they need to survive. The children in Year 3 and 4 will be learning about states of matter, comparing solids, liquids and gases and observing when materials change state.

MUSIC

In music, the children will be following the learning platform Charanga as they focus on the unit 'Bringing Us Together'. The children will be exploring new, and develop prior, musical skills.

HISTORY

As Historians, the children will be learning about Ancient Greece. They will be exploring Greek life and achievements, considering the influence of their lives and achievements on the western world.

Relationships, Health and Education

In RHE, the Year 2 children will be focusing on 'Belonging to a Community' this half term. The Year 3 and 4 children will be focusing on 'Physical Health and Mental Well Being' this half term.

PE

In PE, the children will be working with our Sports Partnership to develop their skills through taking part athletics on the field with Mr Kirk.
