Dear Parents,


We have had a wonderful week of learning in Cedar Class. The children really enjoyed being back together again and learning as a class. They particularly enjoyed PE with Mr Kirk this week practising their Athletics!

In Whole Class Reading this week the children have been reading a new text, using their decoding skill of DERIC to help them to read unfamiliar words. In Writing we have started sentence stacking for our non-chronological report about Earthquakes. The children had some brilliant ideas for their heading using alliteration! In Maths, the Year 3 and 4 children have completed their learning on fractions, comparing, ordering, adding and subtracting them. Meanwhile, the Year 2 children have been solving reasoning questions whilst consolidating their understanding on a range of mathematical concepts. They have been working really hard to unpick the problems and consider how to show their workings.

Across the wider curriculum, we have read the parable of The Good Samaritan in RE and started our learning about the Ancient Greeks in History, considering where they were located and when they were in existence. The children are really excited to be learning History again!
