In history this week, the children have continued their learning about Maya civilisation by learning about the architecture found in their cities and about the importance of trade. The children learnt about the key items that the Maya traded and the uses of these items. They were also able to locate on a map the areas where these items were found and explain how the Maya moved their goods from city to city.
