In Whole Class Reading this week the children have been practising their retrieval skills, looking back through the text that they have already read using their skimming and scanning technique to help them to find the answers. In Writing we have been stacking sentences together to retell Aladdin's experience inside the cave. In Maths the children have been consolidating their understanding of statistics, collecting, presenting and interpreting data about the children in our class.

Across the wider curriculum, the children are really enjoying our fieldwork sessions in Geography, considering the geographical features of the school grounds and the local area of Dunsford. We have focused on the importance of each feature of a sketch map this week, labelling North on our maps and exploring the idea of the map not being drawn to scale.
