

Oak Class Summer 2 Term Curriculum 2022

LITERACY

This half term we will be focusing on writing non-fiction with a focus on balanced arguments. Our lessons focus on the purpose, the intended audience and the features used in balanced arguments. We will use sentence stacking lessons where children will be able to develop their writing skills, specific to this genre of writing, creating high quality sentences. These skills will then be transferred to their independent writing.

MATHS

In Maths this half term we will focus our learning on revisiting different areas of the maths curriculum. This will support all children in their transition to their next year group. The children will use the procedures and methods that they have learnt to consolidate their learning through problems solving. There will be a focus on deepening their understanding of different mathematical concepts through explaining their thinking and proving their answers are correct..

RE

Our unit of learning in RE this half term is to answer the question 'How does faith help people when life gets hard?' In order to answer this question we will be drawing together some previous learning about Christian, Hindu, Jewish and non-religious beliefs. It allows the children to explore religious and non-religious responses to life and consider why some people find that their faith can help them celebrate the good times in life but also to cope with the difficult times.

SCIENCE

In science we will be continuing with our unit of learning on 'materials'. Within this half term children will be investigating changing materials, exploring which materials are soluble, how to separate materials in a solution and investigating materials that undergo irreversible changes. Children will be working scientifically in lessons to answer a range of questions to gain an understanding of this unit.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be learning about Brazil in South America. Children will use a range of sources to understand about the types of settlement and land use, economic activity, and the distribution of natural resources including energy, food, minerals and water in Brazil. Children will also collect and analyse statistics and other information in order to draw conclusions about Brazil's climate and compare it to that of the UK

PE

In PE, children will be developing their striking and fielding skills. They will develop their skills and understanding of cricket and rounders through their lessons. The children will also develop their team working skills, being able to lead a team, work with others and encourage each other. They will continue to develop their learning and skills supported by our collaboration with secondary colleagues at Spires school.

Relationships, Health and Education

In RHE, we will be focusing our learning on our unit 'Understanding That Everyone is Unique and Special'. As part of this unit children will learn about how to be confident in themselves, recognise their talents and learn how to believe in themselves when faced with peer pressure..
