



Cedar Class Summer Term 2 2022

LITERACY

As Writers, Cedar Class will be writing to entertain, creating a final outcome of writing a continuation of the story of Aladdin. The children will be exposed to a range of skills to include in their writing as they 'stack sentences' together as a class to write a section of the story of Aladdin when he is stuck inside a cave. The skills will be transferred into their independent writing when they continue the story after Aladdin has escaped from the cave.

MATHS

As Mathematicians, Cedar Class will be developing their mathematical thinking this half term as they consolidate, and develop, their understanding of the units for the four operations and shape. Alongside this, the Year 4 children will develop their understanding of decimals. The children will apply their mathematical thinking using concrete, pictorial and abstract representations, answering fluency and problem solving questions based upon a range of contexts.

RE

In RE, our learning will focus on the question 'How and why do people try to make the world a better place?'. The children will explore different perspectives from different faiths on how they try to make the world a better place, and then consider how they try to make the world a better place.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, the children in Year 2, 3 and 4 will be exploring and investigating plants, considering the different types of plants and what they need to survive.

MUSIC

In music, the children will be following the learning platform Charanga as they focus on the unit 'Reflect, Rewind & Replay'. The children will be exploring new, and develop prior, musical skills.

GEOGRAPHY

As Geographers, the children will be learning about their local area, Dunsford. They will be taking part in fieldwork activities which support an exploration of their local area, both inside and outside of the school grounds.

Relationships, Health and Education

In RHE, the Year 2, 3 and 4 children will be focusing on 'Physical Health and Mental Well Being' this half term.

PE

In PE, the children will be working with our Sports Partnership to develop their skills through taking part in fielding and striking sports on the field with Mr Kirk.
