Outcomes

Children will use their literacy skills that they have developed in lessons to write a biography about Tutankhamun.

READING

Children will explore a variety of texts focusing on the core skills of: understanding vocabulary; retrieval and inference. Children will use these three skills to study fiction and non-fiction texts.

WRITING

Non-fiction.

Children will develop writing skills through sentence stacking to create an independent biography about the life of Tutankhamun.

SPELLING

Revisiting spelling rules with a focus on prefixes.

HANDWRITING

Children are being supported by 'Letter Join' to improve their letter formation whilst joining their handwriting.



Maths

- Children will develop their understanding of place value before moving on to the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).
- They will use a combination of concrete resources and pictorial representations to support their learning in these areas.

Arithmetic Skills

- Children will develop mental maths strategies to support their fluency.

- Children will take part in daily times tables to support their fluency.
