Dear Families,

We are really excited to be able to share with you that we have organised a two-day, one night residential for Year 4 again at Forest & Beech this year.

Our children have told us that they want more opportunity to make friends across schools, so to support them in this as well as reducing costs for you, we are going to be partnering up with our South Hams schools, Thurlestone, West Alvington, Charleton and also Dartington Academy. Therefore, we are pleased to announce that we will be staying at the Forest and Beach Centre at Beeson, Kingsbridge on **Monday 24<sup>th</sup> June – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> June**.

Forest & Beach is an award-winning outdoor company based in the South Hams. During the two-day residential the children will:

- Set up camp
- Shelter building
- Fire lighting
- Have their evening meal on the beach
- Beach time
- Bat walk
- Archery

Closer to the time, we will give out further details via letters/emails.

The total cost for the trip will be £70.38 per child. We are asking for a non-refundable deposit of £20 to be paid by **30<sup>th</sup> November** to secure your child's place, paid via the MCAS app. The remainder of the balance can be paid over 4 instalments. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will be entitled to attend at a reduced rate. This will be reflected on your MCAS app by showing reduced instalments.
