Oak Class Trip to Tor Royal Farm

To support our Geography learning, we are very excited to be planning a trip to Tor Royal Farm in Princetown as part of the farm to fork project organised by the Dartmoor Farmers Association. This trip will take place on **Wednesday 10th July**.

This year in geography, the children have been learning about natural resources and trade: global, national and local. This trip to Tor Royal Farm will be a fantastic opportunity to deepen this learning and give the children some hands-on experience to consolidate this area of their learning. During the visit, the children will understand how farming contributes to local trade alongside learning about where their food comes from, how farming can contribute to conservation of habitats and species and how actions on the farm can contribute to mitigating against climate change.

The children are asked to come in wearing school uniform with suitable waterproofs and wellington boots. Please can all children bring a snack, a packed lunch and a full, refillable water bottle for the trip. If you would like to order school lunch, please do so using this link:
