Govt guidance:

Schools **must** publish the percentage of pupils within its year 6 cohort in the 2023 to 2024 academic year who met the national curriculum swimming and water safety requirements.

In Year 6, children in England are expected to achieve the following swimming standards:

- 1. **Swim Competently**: They should be able to swim at least 25 meters using a range of strokes effectively.
- 2. **Safe Self-Rescue**: Children should also demonstrate safe self-rescue skills in different water-based situations.
